Following the Kempton Park Feasibility Study, which concluded at the end of 2013, Jockey Club Estates Ltd (JCE) are now keen to start the process to support a planning submission for residential development.

Whilst programme is still being decided – a mid-2015 planning submission is possible. The scheme remains as per the feasibility study – circa 1,500 residential units on underutilised land immediately east of the racecourse.

To that end – JCE have asked me to contact the relevant highway authorities to check availability for pre-application scoping meetings.

It is likely that JCE will be pushing for pre-application scoping meetings before the end of May – to ensure time for necessary traffic data collection before the summer.

Would it be possible to confirm general availability for a meeting mid-May onwards – and we can subsequently firm up on dates, attendees, pre-meeting scoping document issue etc.
