I refer to your email below and apologise for the delay in getting back to you.

The 'report' you refer to was an assessment as to whether Runnymede and Spelthorne broadly lie in the same housing market area. It will form part of the Strategic Housing Market Assessment which both authorities have agreed to progress.

The work is not yet complete but the total cost is likely to be in the order of £28,000.

The report you refer to has not been presented to any Spelthorne Committee or Working Party.

It is intended that when a draft of the full study is completed it will be available for public involvement. However, the work is taking some time and a specific date for involvement has not been set.
